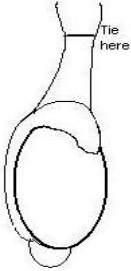
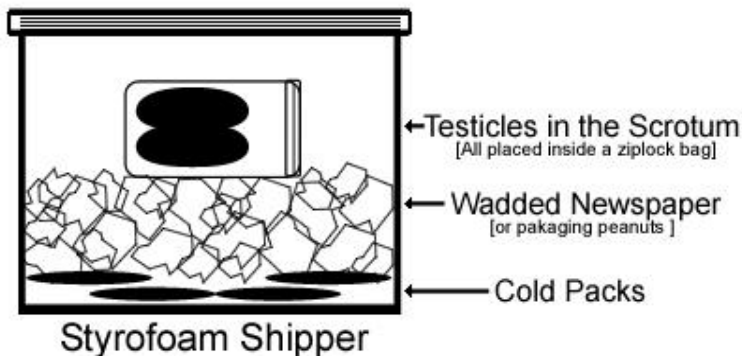


Immediately following euthanasia or as soon as possible after death:

1. Testicles should be left inside scrotum if possible.
2. Collect as much of the ductus (vas) deferens as possible and ligate the ends prior to cutting it off.



3. The testicles should be allowed to cool slowly. The most detrimental aspect of testicle collection is to temperature shock the testicles by cooling them too quickly.
4. The testicles, in the scrotum if possible, should be placed inside a plastic bag and sealed.
5. The bag should be placed over an insulatory material (wadded newspaper, Styrofoam peanuts, bubble wrap) on top of ice packs inside a cooler. The cooling setup should be prepared **immediately before** placing the testicles inside the cooler. The cooler should not be cooled in the top prior to use. The setup allows the testicles to be cooled slowly.



6. If within 30 miles of Bryan, TX, call Global Genetics as soon as possible for pick-up (8am-5pm Mon-Fri).
7. If over 30 miles from Bryan, TX place cooler inside cardboard box and ship to Global Genetics at address above **as soon as possible** by **OVERNIGHT DELIVERY** (to minimize exposure to outside elements). **DO NOT SHIP ON A SATURDAY**. Samples are safe in a refrigerator (after slow cooling in box) over the weekend until able to ship. **Call Global Genetics on day of shipment with expected time of arrival and tracking number.**
